The training will be free and schools receive funding to cover release time for participants to attend face to face sessions. The blended approach, whereby participants do some of the training online (with funding for some release time to support this) proved to be popular last time. Claiming Cover Costs

We extended this opportunity to all participants on the key priority **Problem Solving** and **Reasoning** work groups this year.
